


GALAPAGOS DIVERSE 6D/5N

This is the opportunity to discover the enchanted islands with daily excursions in small groups and lodging at hotels.



6 days/ 5 nights
DAY 1: BALTRA (Airport) – SANTA CRUZ (highland and primicias)
DAY 2: SEYMOUR ISLAND or PLAZAS
DAY 3: ISABELA full day ISLAND (Tintoreras,)
DAY 4: PUERTO AYORA SAN CRISTOBAL
DAY 5: ESPAÑOLA or 360 Degrees
DAY 6: TRANSFER TO (Airport)

DAY1: BALTRA (Airport) – SANTA CRUZ (Highland)

Flight from Quito via Guayaquil to Baltra airport, where your guide will receive you and take you to the main town of Santa Cruz Island, Puerto Ayora. Today you will explore the natural habitat of the giant Galapagos turtles in the highlands of Santa Cruz Island. On the way to the highlands the vegetation changes considerably and turns humid and green. You will visit Primicias Ranch, a reserve for turtles where you will observe the animals in their natural habitat and also have a beautiful view over the island. In the volcanic formation of the highlands you will also discover ancient lava tunnels. **Lunch at Primicias.** Return to the hotel and leisure time in the afternoon. Dinner at a Restaurant in Puerto Ayora. Overnight at Hotel in Puerto Ayora in double accommodation (-/L/-).



DAY 2: PLAZAS

Breakfast. Visit **South Plazas** begins with a dry landing. The rocky trail circumnavigates the island displaying the combination of dry and coastal vegetation zone. The island is home to enormous prickly pear cactus and the endemic succulent sesuvian. These succulents with almond-shaped leaves are green during the rainy season December-May. Then become red during the dry season giving the island an unusual appearance. **Box Lunch Included.** South Plaza has one of the largest populations of land iguanas in the Galapagos. The iguanas seem to be everywhere once you land. These larger than average yellow-brown land iguanas feed on the fruit and pads of the prickly pear cactus. (B/L/-)



OR NORTH SEYMOUR

Visit to **North Seymour**. North of Baltra is the small islet of North Seymour. The two islands are very similar in appearance both created from geological uplift and having typical arid vegetation including prickly pear cactus, palo santos trees and salt bushes.



The visitor trail on North Seymour is approximately (2 km) in length crossing the inland of the island and exploring the rocky coast. Along the way the trail passes colonies of blue-footed boobies and magnificent frigate birds. The magnificent frigate bird, a large black bird with a long wingspan, and a hooked beak, is extremely fast and has excellent vision. **Box Lunch Included.** Frigate birds are known for the large red pouch on their necks. During mating season the males thrown back their heads, inflate the pouch (sometimes to the size of a soccer ball), and shake trying to capture the attention of female frigates. (B/L/-)

DAY 3: ISABELA ISLAND - TINTORERAS

Free day at leisure. (Optional visit to Isabela In the morning we will take a tour to Isabela After a cruise of 2,5h, we will reach this corner of paradise to Puerto Villamil town, we will visit Tintorerass Islets. Herds of white -tip sharks can often be seen here, resting around the lava canals. You can also observe hundreds of marine



iguanas, as "Las Tintoreras" are one of their main breeding sites. On the nearby sandy beaches, sea lions play and relax in the sun. Afterwards we will have an opportunity to snorkel. Return to Puerto Ayora) Overnight. (B/L/-)

DAY 4: SANTA CRUZ TO SAN CRISTOBAL

Early departure by speed boat from Puerto Ayora to San Cristobal Airport, you will be picked-up at the port by your guide and he will take you to the hotel. Lunch in a tortoise farm. Then you will follow the trail to the Frigate bird hill, a viewpoint from which you



can admire beautiful view over the island. You will be able to snorkel in the shallow waters of Tijeretas Bay, where you can see sea lions, various tropical fishes, and turtles. Your hike will finish at Carola beach from where you will go back to the hotel.

DAY 5: ESPANOLA OR SAN CRISTOBAL 360 TOUR

Located two hours from San Cristóbal, Española one of the oldest island in the islands. Despite the dry climate the island is one of the world's only known nesting sites for the Waved Albatross (aka Galapagos Albatross). From April to December this island is covered with these beautiful birds. Blue-Footed and Nazca Boobies as well as many other bird species also call this island home.



Another unique species found only on Española Island is the Green and Red Marine Iguana (also known as Christmas Iguanas). A snorkel activity in Garner bay is included with opportunity to see many schools of fish. In case this tour is not available, a full day tour 360 degrees offering the best relevant points of San Cristobal Island. Wellfare Dinner . (B/L/D)

DAY 6: SAN CRISTOBAL AIRPORT

After breakfast. Transfer in to the airport (B/-/-)
